deserving of this honor and we look forward to working with her in the future.

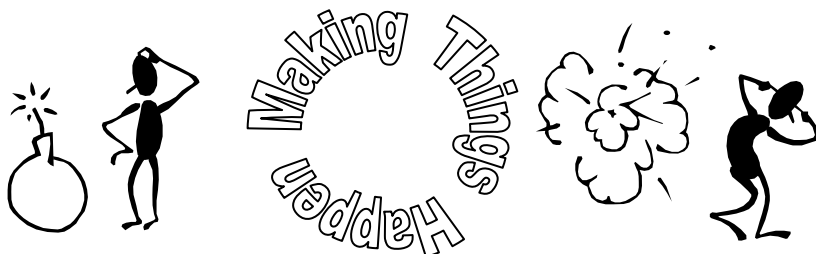

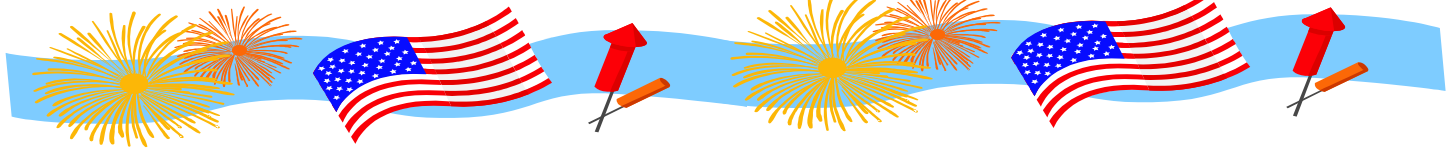
Hello all!
